Nara Prefectural Kashihara Senior High School, founded in 1975, is surrounded by natural beauty and ancient mystery. The nearby imperial burial mounds, 5th and 6th century tumuli, and historic temples and shrines tell the rich story of Kashihara City. The school grounds provide a clear view of Mt. Unebi, an area celebrated for centuries in Japanese poetry as one of the three mountains of Yamato and considered the founding place of Japan by the first Emperor Jimmu.
