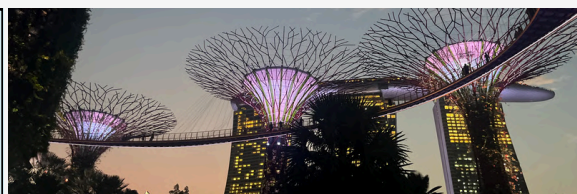


# SINGAPORE STUDY TOUR

### English training program at Singapore Management University

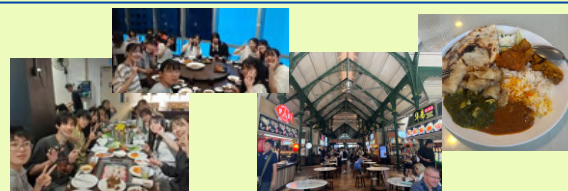
We took a class about sustainability and career in English. And we made a presentation.
